

RESOLUTION NO. 26-06

AN RESOLUTION OF THE PAYETTE COUNTY AMBULANCE DISTRICT, IDAHO, ORDERING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE QUESTION OF AUTHORIZING A PERMANENT SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION, TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$3,265,740); APPROVING A FORM OF BALLOT; PROVIDING FOR REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO

WHEREAS, the Payette County Ambulance District, Idaho (the “District”), is a municipal corporation duly organized and operating under the laws of the state of Idaho; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board of Commissioners (the “Board”) of the District, there is a need for the District to raise additional revenues by means of a permanent supplemental levy in the amount of \$3,265,740; and

WHEREAS, the District is required, pursuant to Section 63-802(1)(h), Idaho Code, to submit the question of authorizing a permanent supplemental levy in a specified amount to the electors of the District and such question must be approved by two-thirds or more of the voters voting on the question.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PAYETTE COUNTY AMBULANCE DISTRICT, Idaho, as follows:

Section 1: A special election is hereby called to be held within the District on Tuesday, May 19, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the District the question set forth in the form of ballot appearing in Section 6 hereof.

Section 2: The special election shall be held as specified in Title 34, Idaho Code, by Payette County and conducted by the Payette County Clerk.

Section 3: The polls of the special election shall open at the hour of 8:00 o’clock a.m. on May 19, 2026, and shall remain open continuously until the hour of 8:00 o’clock p.m., at which time the polls shall be closed.

Section 4: Each person voting at the special election shall be, at the time of the election, a qualified elector of the District, within the meaning of Article 6, Section 2, of the Idaho Constitution, eighteen (18) years of age or older, properly registered, and a United States citizen who has resided in the State of Idaho and in the District at least thirty (30) days next preceding the election.

Section 5: Electors must, in order to vote at the special election, be registered to vote according to the registration records of Payette County, Idaho.

Section 6: The ballot proposition for the special election shall be in substantially the following form:

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS: To vote on the foregoing proposition, please make a cross (X) or other mark in the space to the right of the words "IN FAVOR OF" or "AGAINST" according to how you wish to vote. If you, by mistake or accident, mark, tear, deface, or otherwise mutilate or spoil the ballot, please return it to an election judge and obtain another ballot.

Shall the Board of Commissioners of the Payette County Ambulance District be authorized and empowered to increase the property tax levy and budget of the District pursuant to Idaho Code Section 63-802(1)(h) in order to provide funds to staff, equip, operate, and maintain ambulance and emergency medical services within the District?

The levy shall be used for the maintenance and operation of the District. The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$88.11 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 is expected to increase \$65.44 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value per year.

Section 7: Notice of the special election shall be given prior to said election by publishing the notice of such election in a newspaper having general circulation within the District as set forth in Title 34, Chapter 14, Idaho Code.

Section 8: Any qualified and registered elector of the District may vote by absentee ballot in the manner provided by Idaho Code Section 33-406, as amended.

Section 9: When the polls are closed, the election officials shall immediately proceed to count the ballots cast at the special bond election. The counting shall be continued without adjournment until completed and the result declared. The election judge and clerk shall thereupon certify the returns of the special bond election to the Payette County Clerk, who shall present the results to the Payette County Commissioners.

The Board of County Commissioners for Payette County shall meet within ten (10) days

following the election, or at such time to which said meeting is continued, for the purpose of canvassing the results of the special bond election. The Payette County Clerk shall thereupon certify the election results to the District Clerk.

Section 10: The officers of the District and Payette County are hereby authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 11: This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
